# Recipe of the Month

## Chicken Noodle Soup



### INGREDIENTS

- 1 tablespoon butter
- ½ cup chopped onion
- ½ cup chopped celery
- 4 (14.5 ounce) cans chicken broth
- 1 (14.5 ounce) can vegetable broth
- ½ pound chopped cooked chicken breast
- 1 ½ cups egg noodles
- 1 cup sliced carrots
- ½ teaspoon dried basil
- ½ teaspoon dried oregano
- salt and pepper to taste

### DIRECTIONS

IN A LARGE POT OVER MEDIUM HEAT, MELT BUTTER. COOK ONION AND CELERY IN BUTTER UNTIL JUST TENDER, 5 MINUTES. POUR IN CHICKEN AND VEGETABLE BROTHS AND STIR IN CHICKEN, NOODLES, CARROTS, BASIL, OREGANO, SALT AND PEPPER. BRING TO A BOIL, THEN REDUCE HEAT AND SIMMER 20 MINUTES BEFORE SERVING.
