Tier 1: All Students

- Teach school-wide expectations and procedures
- Positive reinforcement for all students
- Consistent responses for problems/issues
- Recognize good and improved attendance
- Educate and engage students and families
- Set goals and monitor attendance
- Academic coaching
- Attendance interventions
- Identify and address common barriers for completing schoolwork
- Effective procedures and supervision in all facets of the school program
- Effective instruction and communication in all facets of the school program

Tier 2: Selected At-Risk Students

- Increased academic support
- School-based mentors (contact teachers) increase communication and keep parents informed
- Attendance plans, behavior supports put in place
- Provide personalized early outreach
- Meet to develop a tailored action plan
- Teach self-management skills
- Implement a check in – check out system

Tier 3: Targeted High-Risk Students

- Intensive case management
- Individual attendance and/or academic plan
- Parent collaboration
- Coordination of public agencies / Community resources
- Legal responses as needed
