Kindergarten Registration and Screening Information

Enrolling in kindergarten is an exciting, yet anxious, time in each parent's and child's life. The Newark City Schools is dedicated to making the registration and screening process as stress-free as possible. We hope the answers to these frequently asked questions will make the registration process an enjoyable one.

When is Kindergarten registration?

Kindergarten registration is scheduled for **March 30-April 9** at the Roosevelt Administrative Offices, 621 Mount Vernon Road **daily from 8-4** with **Wednesday hours 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.**

Newark City Schools uses online student registration. Please visit www.newarkschools.us. The New Student Registration tab will be on the left side of the screen, click and it will take you to the registration page. Complete all pages of the forms, submit and log out. **Appointments are needed to complete your online forms registration. You can call 740-670-7008 to schedule your appointment. Your child does not need to be present.** Registering your child now assists the district in planning and placing your child in the appropriate kindergarten setting.

What is the cut-off date for entrance to Kindergarten?

Children must be five (5) years old on or before **September 30** to enroll in kindergarten. For information concerning early entrance to Kindergarten, contact Stephanie DeBevoise, Gifted Coordinator at 740-670-7053.

What documentation do I need to register my child?

Parents/Guardians must have the following documents to complete registration.

- Birth certificate
- Immunization record
- Proof of residency (such as a current paid utility bill, rental agreement/lease, mortgage, etc)
- Proof of custody (in divorce or foster situation)
- Photo ID

What is Kindergarten screening?

Kindergarten screening is scheduled by each building and occurs before they start school in August. You will be contacted by the school to schedule an appointment. During screening, your child will participate in tasks designed to assess the development of science, mathematics, language and literacy, physical well-being and motor skills. This screening takes approximately 60 minutes.
